When you are thankful for how God is working in your life, worship comes more naturally. But when your prayer requests do not seem to lead to the answers you want, worship becomes a little more difficult to do. You might even be tempted to wonder: "How do I love God when it seems like He has failed me?"

We can learn from the experience of Paul and Silas in Acts 16:13-34. Even as their circumstances changed, their worship remained constant. That is because they viewed their circumstances through the lens of who God is, and not the other way around.

ALWAYS OBEY GOD

By obeying God, not only do you spare yourself from having to deal with the consequences of disobedience, you are also worshipping Him in the process.

Paul and Silas always obeyed God by going on a missionary journey to Philippi, a Roman colony. During their time there, they shared the gospel (Acts 16:13-15) and cast out a demon from a slave girl (Acts 16:16-18).

WORSHIP GOD IN ALL SITUATIONS

Paul and Silas were subsequently arrested (Acts 16:19-21) under the pretense of teaching customs that were not aligned with what the Romans practiced. Not even granted a fair investigation nor trial, Paul and Silas were disrobed and they were beaten up by rods. After taking several blows, they were then imprisoned, with their feet fastened in the stocks. (Acts 16:22-24).

Violated and embarrassed, Paul and Silas did not lose heart. Even in prison, they still prayed and sang hymns (Acts 16:25). As they were doing so, the jailers and their fellow prisoners were also hearing their praise. It's an important reminder for us believers that when bad things happen to us, the world is watching how we will respond. Our reaction can point people to, or drive them away, from God.

EXPERIENCE GOD'S POWER

In what can only be described as a miracle, an earthquake shook the prison where Paul and Silas were being illegally detained. Not only did all the doors swing open, but all the chains were unfastened (Acts 16:25-26). The jailer was roused from his sleep and assumed that all the prisoners escaped. Not wanting to face the ignominy of a massive failure, he was about to kill himself (Acts 16:27). But Paul cried out to the jailer, informing him that they're all still in their cells. The jailer, trembling with fear, asked Paul and Silas "Sirs, what must I do to be saved?" (Acts 16:28-30). To which they answered, "Believe in the Lord Jesus, and you will be saved, you and your household." And that is exactly what happened (Acts 16:31-34).

> Even in that setting, Paul and Silas experienced God's power by witnessing how He can use this tough episode to reach out to the jailer. And the jailer experienced God's power when his entire household was saved.

> > Worship sets us free because it is not dependent on our circumstances; it's anchored on His unchanging character. And what we know of Him is that He is good, He loves us, and He will always be worthy of our praise!
