VE FID, dedicate your best

LAST WEEK'S MESSAGE

"You shall love the LORD your God with all your heart and with all your soul and with all your strength."

This was God's command to His people in Deuteronomy 6:5 — but sometimes earthly desires such as money, career, dreams, comfort, relationships, and family occupy our hearts and become more important to us than God. How do we then love God more than these desires and dedicate our best to Him?

To dedicate our best to God, we must protect our hearts from lusts, worries, and idols, and remember that His provision is sufficient (Proverbs 3:9-10, Matthew 6:33). We can learn more about this from Hannah, Samuel's mother, who exemplified this in the Bible.

be in God's presence

In 1 Samuel 1:3, we see that Hannah and her husband Elkanah were devoted to the LORD. However, Hannah was faced with affliction: she was childless because "the LORD had closed her womb" (v. 5) and she was bitterly provoked by Peninah, Elkanah's second wife, who had children (vv. 6-8). When Hannah was greatly distressed, she went to the LORD and poured out her soul before Him (vv. 9-11, 12-15).

Hannah sought God and trusted Him completely because she knew who God is. This enabled her to dedicate Samuel to Him, because we cannot dedicate something important to us to someone we don't know. We need to know God and be in His presence constantly, and to desire Him more than our own earthly idolatries. Peace, comfort, and clarity can only be found in the presence of God who knows us intimately, including our struggles, what's good for us, and all our ways and decisions (Psalm 139:1-3).

set your joy in God

As she wept before the LORD, part of Hannah's prayer was a vow dedicating her child to the LORD should He remember her (v. 11). She had joy while waiting (v. 18), and worshipped God even before her prayer was answered (v. 19). When God

finally gave them Samuel, Hannah kept her word (vv. 21-22), and with Elkanah, worshipped God and dedicated Samuel to the LORD (v. 23). She was willing to forego seeing Samuel as he grew up in the house of the LORD because "as long as he lives he is dedicated to the LORD" (vv. 24-28).

Our natural tendency is to find our joy in the fulfillment of our desires, but the more we fix our eyes on our desires, the more they become idols. Instead, let us focus on Jesus, the author and perfecter of our faith (Hebrews 12:1), that we may be able to dedicate our best to the LORD. The presence of God ultimately satisfies our greatest need and greatest longing!

Thank Him always

Upon receiving God's answer to her prayers, Hannah rejoiced in the LORD (1 Samuel 2:1-10), recognizing His holiness and how He is all-knowing. His thoughts are not our thoughts, and His ways are not our ways (Isaiah 55:8-9)! In fact, God prepared both Samuel and Hannah for the future: Hannah could not have expected it in her prayers (1 Samuel 2:10), but Samuel was to anoint the first two kings of Israel including King David, and he became a greatly respected prophet in all Israel (1 Samuel 3:19-20)! Additionally, God blessed Hannah by allowing her to visit Samuel every year (1 Samuel 2:18-19), and as Eli the priest blessed her and Elkanah, God gave them other children as well (vv. 20-21).

Worship is continued gratefulness to God — no matter how He answers our prayers. When we are not in the presence of God and are not willing to dedicate our best to Him, we become miserable. "Those who contend with the Lord will be shattered" (1 Samuel 2:10). But if we worship the LORD, He keeps us secure. We need to be men and women who will worship God for who He truly is.

God did the greatest act of dedicating one's best: He gave up His Son, Jesus Christ, to die on the cross and save us from our sins. As a grateful response, let us love God and dedicate our best to Him: because of who He is, what He has done, and what He can do in and through us.
