In Colossians 1:28-29, Paul shared how he proclaims Christ to people to "present every man complete in Christ". This did not mean perfection but maturity: to reach full potential and become all that God willed for them to be. We cannot do this alone and are not sufficient on our own - our adequacy is from God (2 Corinthians 3:5)! Knowing this, however, does not mean there are no difficulties in life. We sometimes find ourselves in a downward spiral or overcome by our emotions, but like Paul, we can combat that by fully understanding who Jesus is.

Paul expressed how he struggled to pray for the Colossians and Laodiceans, that their hearts will be encouraged and that they would truly know Christ Himself, in whom treasures of wisdom and knowledge are found (Colossians 2:1-3). The problem in Colossae was the proliferation of deceptive people, so Paul yearned to see the church's "good discipline and stability of [their] faith in Christ" (v. 5). He tells them that since they received Christ they must "walk in Him", to keep obeying and following Jesus. Such is the Christian life: that after coming to Christ, we should walk in Him, rooted and now being built up in Him, established in the faith, and overflowing with gratitude (vv. 6-7). Is our life marked by rootedness, overflowing joy, and gratitude? Christ is all-sufficient, and He is always purposeful even in our challenges!

The people were then warned against delusional philosophies and empty deception (v. 8). Many of the false teachings during that time are still prevalent now:

- Mysticism: worship of angels and mediators
- Syncretism: combination of different beliefs and philosophies to reach God
- Gnosticism: the salvation is achieved through special knowledge Legalism: keeping standards of behavior to be saved
- Asceticism: imposes man-made rules or severe self-discipline to gain favor from God

The Bible tells us this is not the way! We must beware of any teaching that diminishes our view of Jesus or draws us away from Him. We need to have a proper high view of Christ, our all-sufficient Savior.

JESUS IS GOD

Jesus is all-sufficient because He is GOD! Colossians 2:9 tells us that in Christ "all the fullness of Deity dwells in bodily form". John confirmed this (John 1:1-3, 14, 18) and Jesus said that of Himself (John 10:30-33), even as He was accused of blasphemy for claiming to be God. If Jesus is God and He dwells in us, then we have what we truly need in life.

JESUS COMPLETES US

Anything other than or in addition to Jesus that we think will complete us or our happiness is an idol. In Jesus we are made complete (Colossians 2:10) and we are granted "everything pertaining to life and godliness" (2 Peter 1:3-4). In Him we are circumcised, which is a spiritual matter (Deuteronomy 3:6, Romans 2:29) where God gives us a new heart and puts His Spirit in us to cause us to obey (Ezekiel 36:26-27). With Jesus we are also baptized (Colossians 2:12): we die in our sins, receive His forgiveness, and are made alive with Him (v. 13, Romans 6:1-3). He paid all our sins in full on the cross and is victorious by His resurrection, enabling us to live a transformed and renewed life!

JESUS GIVES US TRUE FREEDOM

True freedom is not the ability to do what you like doing when you feel like it, but the power to say no to sin and yes to God. Knowing these things about Jesus, we are set free from manmade religious ideals and traditions (vv. 20-23). We are no longer under the power of sin or law but under Christ, therefore we must use this freedom not to sin but to serve God (Galatians 5:13-14), deny ungodliness, and lead sensible, righteous, and godly lives (Titus 2:11-12). It is Jesus who set people free, and indeed, HE IS ALL-SUFFICIENT!
