Have a Fresh Encounter with God

Forty is a significant measurement of time in the Bible, as forty years usually depicts a generation. As we celebrate our 40th anniversary, we are reminded that our church is all about God, and that He has given us a mission: to MAKE DISCIPLES. Even as we reach this milestone, we still have a lot of work to do and the work has just begun! In our metropolis alone, there are millions of people who need to hear about Jesus and we, believers also need to have a fresh encounter with God daily.

Let us look into the amazing life and ministry of Isaiah, who served God under five kings in Judah for almost 60 years and remained faithful to God because he had a fresh encounter with Him.

Isaiah 6:1-3

When King Uzziah died, the kingdom of Judah was filled with worries, fears, instabilities, and challenges — but it was also around this time when Isaiah saw the LORD on His throne (Isaiah 6:1). This served as a reminder that kings and leaders may come and go, but God is still ON THE THRONE (Psalm 135:6, Ephesians 1:11). God wanted Isaiah to know His majesty and greatness first and foremost. In 6:2-3, Isaiah described the Seraphim, the superbeings that are in God's presence, obeying Him, and exalting His absolute goodness and holiness. In the book of Revelation, they were also still praising our holy, holy, holy God (Revelation 4:8)!

God is HOLY, and we submit to His authority because of who He is. He is distinct as the Creator, His moral perfection is undisputed, and He is the example of moral purity (light). He has absolute power, and is absolutely pure and good (1 John 1:5). Out of His love, He sent His Son Jesus to die for the forgiveness of our sins.

God, in His sovereignty, also has absolute control. We can have peace knowing there are no accidents in life (Romans 8:28-29) and that He is the source of our confidence (Romans 8:31-32). As a church we reckon that we had to leave the previous place we were renting for our worship center. Although it was a sad decision, God provided for us our own home at the CCF Center, our base of operation for a global discipleship movement!

Isaiah 6:4-7

When Isaiah encountered the Lord, he saw his imperfection as a "man of unclean lips" (v.5). He saw his own sinfulness and regarded himself as ruined, even if it was just probably out of saying something bad

(Matthew 15:18). This reveals that until we realize that we are sinners, we will not understand the grace of God and our need for a Savior. Comparing our holiness with others is useless, because compared to Jesus, we are broken and need grace and mercy.

The Seraphim drew near to the humbled Isaiah, and the angel provided forgiveness and purification for him (vv.6-7). This was a prophetic picture involving the altar where the burnt sacrifice is offered, and the sanctification that resulted after it. We come before God to admit we are sinners, and we receive God's gracious forgiveness. A high view of God and a proper view of ourselves will then allow us to see the needs of others.

Isaiah 6:8

After Isaiah was forgiven and cleansed, he heard the Lord asking, "Whom shall I send, who will go for Us?" (Isaiah 6:8). The moment Isaiah sensed this need, he immediately volunteered and said, "HERE AM I, SEND ME!". This shows that he knew the gospel and understood the ministry of the Messiah, even prophesying about it (Isaiah 53:5-6).

Romans 1:14-16 similarly shows the heart of the Apostle Paul. After encountering Jesus, he considered himself "under obligation", he was "eager to preach the gospel" and was not ashamed of it "for it is the power of God for salvation to everyone who believes" (v.16). Sinners cannot escape God's judgment... and all of us are sinners (Revelation 20:11-12,15; 21:8)! God is holy and will judge evil — yet when we come to Jesus, admit we are sinners, believe in Him and accept the grace He offers for the forgiveness of our sins, we receive God's mercy and salvation.

People are lost without Jesus, and they need to hear the Good News — but you will not be able to share the gospel if you have not experienced it. Have you surrendered your life to God? Are you ready to volunteer and say, "Here am I, send me"? Stop playing games! Admit you are a sinner, believe in Jesus as Savior and Lord, and receive forgiveness for your sins.

Let us serve God and lead others to a fresh encounter with Him as we continue walking with Him in the next forty years! Blessed 40th anniversary CCF family and all praises, honor and glory be to God the Father, to the ever-present Holy Spirit, and to our Lord and Savior Jesus Christ!
