LAST WEEK'S MESSAGE

Read Daniel 12

Why do we study biblical prophecy? Biblical prophecy validates who God is and the Bible as God's reliable word, helps us grow in faith, prepares us for eternity, and inspires us to tell others about Jesus. Daniel 12 is full of end-times prophecies — what can we learn from them?

GOD'S KINGDOM LASTS FOREVER

In Daniel 2, King Nebuchadnezzar of Babylon had a dream that was anxious to understand but withheld information about. None of the wise men in all of Babylon were able to help him, but Daniel was able to describe the dream in detail to the king and interpret it (Daniel 2:31-45). The statue in Nebuchadnezzar's dream represents world kingdoms in history: head = Babylon (vv.37-38), chest and arms = Medo-Persian Empire (v.39), belly and thighs = Greece (v.39), legs = Rome (v.40), and the feet/ten toes are presumed to be the revived Roman empire (vv.41-43). The stone that struck the feet of iron and clay that crushed the statue is Jesus Christ (Acts 4:11-12)!

Eventually, Daniel had a vision of four beasts (Daniel 7:1-8), which was mirrored by the next one in Daniel 8. He had dreams about the Medo-Persian empire (ram with two horns) that was conquered by the Greek empire (Daniel 8:1-8) through Alexander the Great (male goat with a big horn). After his death, four of his generals — Cassander, Lysimachus, Seleucus, and Ptolemy — took control of the empire and historically divided it among themselves. All were eventually beaten by the Romans as prophesied.

Only the prophecy about the feet/ten toes has not yet been fulfilled, but just like how the Babylonian empire which was conquered by the Medo-Persian kingdom in Daniel's lifetime (Daniel 5:30-31), this prophecy will be fulfilled, and this future kingdom will also be destroyed. Only God's kingdom will remain forever!

GOD'S PEOPLE WILL BE TESTED

Part of Daniel's visions was one of "a little horn which grew exceedingly great" (Daniel 8:9-11). This prophecy alludes to Antiochus Epiphanes ("god manifest") who was one of the generals who succeeded Alexander the Great and "magnified himself" to be equal to God. In 175-164 B.C., he committed the "abomination of desolation" by sacrificing a pig inside the temple in Jerusalem. This prophecy has "double fulfillment" where it will be fulfilled again in a future event. A future "Roman empire" (the fourth beast), which could be a revived Roman Empire, will still arise (Daniel 7:7). This "beast" is described as having ten horns in Revelation 13:1, it parallels the prophecy in Daniel 7 (vv. 7-8, 21).

Rome crushed their enemies and ruled over conquered nations with an iron fist unlike any other kingdom before it. And just like how Daniel was tested (Daniel 1:8, 3:18, 6:10), God's people were tested then, during the Roman empire, and now. According to Open Doors, 365 million Christians are persecuted worldwide as of this year. There is a spread and imposition of liberal worldviews (legislation, social media), and there is also the threat of economic and social loss if Christians do not conform to worldviews. We will also be tempted to compromise our faith and disobey God. The love of self, money, and pleasure; division, unforgiveness; living a double life, and DIY/fake Christianity are themselves signs of the end times that Paul and Jesus warned us about.

GOD'S SON, JESUS, WILL RETURN

Daniel 9:24-26 describes a 70-week timeline: the first 69 "weeks" being 483 years from the time of Daniel up to the decree to rebuild Jerusalem (445 B.C.), its restoration in 396 B.C., and the "silent years" between the Old and New Testament that followed. An unknown time gap follows that includes the life, death, and resurrection of Jesus, the destruction of Jerusalem in 70 A.D., and the "Church Age" which continues until today up to the arrival of the 70th "week". In the 70th week there will be a 7-year covenant between the Antichrist and Israel which will be broken "mid-week" (3.5 years), the second fulfillment of the "abomination of desolation" (Matthew 24:15-16), and a tribulation period. But it culminates with "complete destruction of the one who makes desolate" - the final and forever defeat of Satan! The Ancient of Days will come and His people will possess the everlasting kingdom (Daniel 7:14, 21-22). God's people will be rescued in the "time of distress" and those who are in the Book of Life will "awake" to everlasting life, with those who lead people to Jesus shining like stars forever (Daniel 12:1-3)!
