HONOR GOD FOR WHO HE IS!

LAST WEEK'S MESSAGE

Many things cause us to be disappointed: people, circumstances — and sometimes, we even get disappointed in God. But our disappointments can disappear when we know God based on who He really is and not just on our past experiences. In knowing Him, we will be encouraged and desire to serve, trust, worship, and honor Him in our lives.

In Malachi, we can learn four things about who God really is:

GOD IS JUST (MALACHI 3:1-4)

The people during Malachi's time were discouraged because they were under a foreign government. People grumbled, lacked passion and devotion for God, and had a wrong view of Him. They asked, "Where is the God of justice?" (Malachi 2:17), but were met with a prophetic statement about God's coming messenger (fulfilled in John the Baptist) and the coming Messiah (Jesus Christ). This guarantees that the day of God's righteous judgment upon the world will be brought to fulfillment through Jesus (Acts 17:30-31)!

Just like them, we may think that life is unfair and blame our past or present circumstances. But we need to remember: God uses our problems and difficulties to refine our character — He will even sacrifice our comfort to sanctify us, and He disciplines us for our good towards righteousness and holiness (Hebrews 12:10-11). Our circumstances are temporary, but His promises are eternal. What we need to do is repent, focus on God, trust Him completely, and do what He asks of us. He is perfect, just, faithful, righteous, and upright (Deuteronomy 32:3-4)!

GOD IS IMMUTABLE (MALACHI 3:5-7)

Sorcery, adultery, oppression, greed, lying, and the like were just some of the sins prevalent during the days of Malachi (vv. 5-6). The people disobeyed and rebelled against God; yet God — in His unchanging character, righteousness, holiness, and love — desired for them to return and repent (v. 7) and withheld His judgment upon them. In the same way, God calls us to repent of our sins and draw near to Him instead of running away from Him (James 4:8).

GOD OWNS EVERYTHING (MALACHI 3:8-9)

Jesus tells us that "where our treasure is, there our hearts will be also" (Matthew 6:21). When the people

asked, "How shall we return?" (v.7), God told them that they were robbing Him in their tithes and contributions (vv. 8-9). Tithe means ten percent, and the Mosaic Law mentions that the "tithe of the land" belongs to God (Leviticus 27:30). But prior to this, Abraham and Jacob already understood this principle and gave their tenths to God (Genesis 14:19-20, 28:22). Jesus said that He came not to abolish this Law but to fulfill it (Matthew 5:17-19), and even the scribes and Pharisees of His day tithed (Matthew 23:23). In keeping with this principle, we give the first ten percent of our earnings to the Lord and use the rest faithfully.

Paul also mentioned proportionate or "grace giving" (1 Corinthians 16:1-2), and cited examples of poor believers who gave joyfully according to their means because they loved the Lord (2 Corinthians 1-5). Everything in the world belongs to God (Psalm 50:10-12) and we honor Him by knowing so, but we rob Him when we are greedy and covetous. The antidote to greed and covetousness is giving, and we can test our spirituality when we look at how we deal with our possessions.

GOD IS A REWARDER (MALACHI 3:10-18)

Finally, God presented a challenge to His people: to "bring the whole tithe into the storehouse (temple)" for Him to "pour out blessings until it overflows" (v. 10). We can never outgive God (Luke 6:38)! He is a rewarder of those who seek Him (Hebrews 11:6), and if we trust in Him, He will provide and fight for us (vv. 11-12). He even corrects our wrong view of Him and helps us discern between righteous and evil men (vv. 14-18).

If we don't truly know God and put our hope in His amazing promises, His Word will not impact our lives and we will not be able to honor Him. Let us draw near to Him, learn to trust Him completely, and do everything for His glory!
